What products should I bring to the Collection?

Look for the words: **Caution, Warning, Poison, Corrosive, Toxic, Volatile, Flammable or Danger** on the label.

How Do I Dispose of Hazardous Waste?

- ◆ **What is a unit? One unit equals up to 5 gallons of liquid waste or up to 20 pounds of dry waste or a combination.)**
- ◆ Residents from participating towns may bring up to 2 units to the Depot at no charge. More than 2 units will be subject to a per unit charge of **\$30.00.**
- ◆ Residents from non-participating towns are subject to a per unit fee and must pay the contractor in cash or by check. **(\$30.00 per unit)**
- ◆ Keep hazardous waste in original container **DO NOT MIX. If leaking wrap in plastic bag and place in a separate box.**
- ◆ Place materials in a secure box.
- ◆ Place secured box in trunk or truck bed.
- ◆ Remain in your vehicle.
