The Selectmen signed the renewal liquor license application for Backstrap.

Looking like the well for the Transfer Station will be put off until the spring.

Tony will get some quotes for the groundwork and the 8x8 well house.

The Eustis Selectmen want Coplin Plantation to Reach out to the residents and have a public hearing about what Coplin wants to do. See if they are for de-organizing, try to merge with Eustis, or stay the same. Until Coplin Plantation decides that they as a whole want to merge with Eustis, The Eustis Selectboard is stepping back until further word from Coplin. Rachel will send Danny a letter.

Sprague was awarded The Ed MacDonald Safety Enhancement grant. He submitted a request to the selectmen to approve the purchase of a Scuba Fill Station. Steve made a motion to accept the Fore Tech quote for \$5,000.00 for the Scuba Fill Station. Jed 2nd, Steve, Amanda, Brandi, & Jed in favor.

As of November 12, 2021, the town has acquired 5 Properties due to unpaid property taxes. One of them Rachel reached out to on Facebook, they have other properties they pay for, so this must be a mistake. 2 of them are now town owned for a year. It's time to act. Rachel will check with MMA about Deeds on tax acquired properties, and if there is recapture form Maine Care of a tax acquired property. This will be discussed again at the next meeting.

Steve is having a phone conference with Joel Smiley, Jason, Jack Conway, Sarah, Jed, and Peter about a possible project in Eustis on Monday. He will let the board know more next meeting.
